

## **Asia University Regulations for Recognition and Discipline of Student Organizations**

2002.05.27 Approved by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Student Affairs Meeting of the 2001 Academic Year  
2005.06.22 Amended the name of university regulations (Asia University) by the 5<sup>th</sup> University Affairs Meeting of the 2004 Academic Year  
2011.01.27 Amended Article 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Student Affairs Meeting of the 2010 Academic Year

Student Organizations and organization officers with one of the following situations may be awarded in accordance with Regulations for Student Recognition and Discipline of Asia University:

- Article 1 A student organization is evaluated as an excellent organization in or outside the university.
- Article 2 Students participate in inter-university or off-campus activities and obtain outstanding performance.
- Article 3 Students hold innovative activities to improve the culture of the university.
- Article 4 Students' other excellent performances are well recognized.
- Article 5 If a student organization violates laws, regulations of the university or disrupts public order and good morals, the offender and the leader will be disciplined according to regulations of the university and the student organization may be warned, forbidden to hold activities or revoked for the registration depending on the severity of the offense after Office of Student Affairs holds Student Affairs Meeting to resolve.
- Article 6 When a student disagree on the resolved discipline, the student should submit a grievance to Student Affairs Meeting for deliberation within two weeks of the announcement of discipline result. When activities has been terminated for a year, the university can revoke the registration as a student organization.
- Article 7 The regulations have been approved by Student Affairs Meeting and ratified by the principal for implementation. The same procedure should also be followed for amended regulations.
