Advertising Guidelines for Announcement of Student Organizations

Article 1 Advertising Guidelines for Announcement of Student Organizations are specifically established according to Guidelines for Student Organizations for keeping poster boards neat, announcing effective activities and managing boards conveniently.

Article 2 Extra-Curricular Activities Section is in charge of managing posters of student organizations and implementing these guidelines.

Article 3 Student organizations should apply via Poster Report System of Extra-Curricular Activities Section in advance and the poster must have the seal of approval before being posted.

Article 4 Posters should be stuck on specific boards. Student organizations should also pay attention to other effective posters on boards and can not tear down or cover other posters.

Article 5 Student organizations have to tear down their own overdue posters. The university or other organizations may tear down posters instead if a student organization does not do it.

Article 6 When the university needs to utilize all bulletin boards for major celebrations or special events, all student organizations should temporarily not post announcements.

Article 7 If a student organization violates these guidelines, it is forbidden to post announcements for a semester.

Article 8 The guidelines have been approved by Student Affairs Meeting and ratified by the principal for implementation. The same procedure should also be followed for amended guidelines.
